



Daracon Croft Racing ready for NSW title

Despite a limited campaign this season the Gunnedah based Daracon Croft Racing Dirt Late Model Team are confident of a strong performance in the NSW Late Model Championship to be held at Tamworth City Speedway April 24 / 25.

“We have only contested a handful of meetings this season but on each occasion we have been on the pace so we are eyeing off the NSW title with some confidence” said team principal / driver Ken Croft.

“Our most recent start was in the South Australian Late Model Championship at The Edge Hotel Motel Timmis Speedway over Easter. We had a good run going there, and won a Heat on the Friday night before breaking the yoke on the tailshaft late in the program. We were able to repair the car for Sundays racing and after starting out of position seven in the 40 lap Main the Daracon 71 was coming on strong and challenging for third when the caution lights flashed on lap 37. After the restart Matt Crimmins got through on the inside so we had to settle for 5th.”

“I was really happy with how the team, and the car, performed, and I know we are a contender for the NSW title. With the event in our ‘backyard’, so to say, it would be a real thrill to stand on the podium in front of a ‘home’ crowd”.

“We have tested at Tamworth a few times this season, and I really enjoy racing there, but we are also under no illusion that we will face stiff opposition for the crown. There are plenty of good drivers in the Dirt Late Model ranks now, and a lot of teams who have prepared these cars for a number of seasons, so they know what to do to get their driver into the winners circle” Croft said.

“The South Australian Late Model Association and Mildura Speedway Drivers Club did a fantastic job of promoting and organising the South Australian Late Model title. It was a pleasure to travel down there to race”.

“If the NSW Late Model Championship is as well organised by ELMA and Tamworth Speedway Club than the race fans will be in for a real treat”.

“I really enjoy the challenge of a long race, so watch out for the Daracon 71 Pontiac in the main event!” concluded Croft.
