A strong run at Tamworth Speedway (NSW) Saturday April 24 has the Port Macquarie based SKM Motorsport Dirt Late Model Team in a confident mood heading into the Queensland Late Model title at Maryborough Speedway (QLD) May 1 and 2.

“It was a shame the NSW Late Model title (set down for April 25 at Tamworth Speedway) was rained out as the SKM Motorsport Team enjoyed a strong run on night one” said Team Principal / Driver Neil Wallace.

“The car was really hooked up, with an almost perfect setup, and it showed in the results with two firsts and a fourth in the Heats, and second place in the 20 lap Final”.

“That was just the type of hit out we needed heading into the inaugural Queensland title this weekend” Wallace said.

“It was just about as perfect night as you could get, given all the car problems we have experienced this year”.

“The NSW title has been rescheduled to the start of next season so now our focus is concentrated solely on doing well in the Queensland title” said Wallace.

“We competed at Maryborough Speedway early in the season and achieved some good results, so I know that we will be a contender for the victory. Just to get on the podium will be tough though, as there are plenty of top racers in the field”.

“The Queensland Late Model guys have enjoyed a good season, with solid car numbers, and some fine racing. They also know the Maryborough track very well. When you throw in visitors like Brad Blake, Darryl Grimson, Nathan Disney etc you can see the challenge facing us”.

“The Maryborough Speedway Club always go out of their way to ensure that everyone has a good time, so we are really looking forward to competing in the inaugural Queensland title” concluded Wallace.

The Queensland Late Model title is the final meeting for the SKM Motorsport team in season 2009/10.
