Daracon Croft Racing aim for victory in South Australian Late Model Title

The Gunnedah based Daracon Croft Racing Dirt Late Model Team are heading south at Easter, with their sights set on claiming the South Australian Late Model Title to be held at The Edge Hotel Motel Timmis Speedway (Mildura VIC).

Contested over two nights, Friday April 2 and Sunday April 4, the event is set to significantly boost the profile of the division in South Australia and Victoria.

“It would be a real bonus for the Daracon Croft Racing Team if we are able to stand on the top of the podium Sunday night at Mildura” said Daracon Croft Racing Team principal and driver Ken Croft.

“The members of the South Australian Late Model Association are putting in the hard work to ensure that the race is a total success. From assistance with accommodation, right through to a supplier for methanol, they have made sure the competitor is being well looked after and kept informed. It really is a pleasure to be a part of the South Australian Late Model title”.

“40 laps around Mildura will be tough, and it will all come down to car setup, and track conditions”.

“I really enjoy the longer races though, as it allows you to settle into a rhythm, and use a bit of strategy. We were running well in the later stages of the 25 lap Tyrepower Late Model Grand National at Parramatta a few weeks ago only to get caught up in an unavoidable wreck. It was nothing more than a racing incident, but it was also somewhat frustrating, as we had more car speed than our opposition, and I was setting myself for a real go at the end” Croft said.

“But that type of stuff happens in racing sometimes, and you get over it pretty quickly and just keep moving forward”.

“The Parramatta wreck left us with some front and rear end repairs to be carried out prior to Mildura, but we had the parts on hand, so it’s all systems go for the South Australian Late Model title”.

“It should be a great event, and the entire team is looking forward to participating” concluded Croft.
