"It was a real eye opener, and I gained a lot of Dirt Late Model knowledge while I was over there. The trip allowed me to cement a solid friendship with Wisconsin racer Al Atkinson. Back in 2007 Al helped me immensely, and Disney Motorsports repaid the favour by bringing Al out to run selected shows here earlier this year. Al, and his Badger Motorsports Team, will be our main support mechanism while in the states on this trip also" Disney said.

"I will be racing a GRT in the Open Late Model class, while Jamie will steer a Wild chassis prepared by Badger Motorsports. For the first few shows I'll be helping to prepare and crew the car Jamie is campaigning, just to help him get settled in a little".

"At this stage we are hoping to do three race meetings a week, so as you can imagine we're pretty pumped!"

"We intend to check out the latest Dirt Late Model developments while over there, and will bring some gear in ready for next season".
