Fuel pressure problems meant the SKM Motorsport #97 Rocket was parked on the infield in the two races contested at Gunnedah on March 15.

“It was really frustrating, that’s for sure” commented SKM Motorsport team principal and driver Neil Wallace. “You try to cover all your bases in car preparation but sometimes things are just thrown up to challenge you”.

“I really have to thank the crew, and my fellow ELMA racers, who worked hard in the Gunnedah pits to make sure we got back out on the track. After starting rear of field in the feature I was making some headway, only for the fuel regulator to pack it in after a couple of laps”.

“Sitting on the infield watching the other guys go around is not my idea of fun so we will be going through the entire fuel system this week to ensure everything is working ok for Parramatta Saturday night”.

“I am really happy with how the ex Bruce MacKenzie Rocket is performing, we just need to get this fuel pressure issue sorted out” concluded Wallace.

The ex Scott McPherson Swartz is available as a turn-key complete with 400ci engine while the ex Chace Karpenko Ludlow is available as a rolling chassis.
